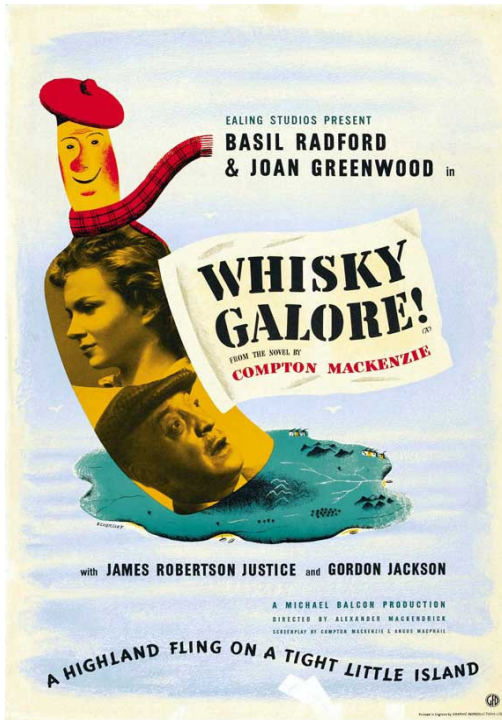


# Tartan Day Film Festival

To celebrate Scotland and Tartan Day, the Saltire Society of New York in conjunction with the Brooklyn College Film Department, will sponsor a screening and talk on **Whisky Galore** and **The Maggie** – two films made in Scotland. The event will take place in the **Woody Tanger Auditorium of the LaGuardia Hall Library** at Brooklyn College on April 5<sup>th</sup> 2016 from 12:30pm until 5:00pm.



The 1949 film of **Whisky Galore** is based on some crazy, but true events. During WWII, rationing predominates all of Scotland – the Scots living on an island in the Outer Hebrides are largely unaffected by shortages – until their whisky supply runs dry. As if by providence a ship full of crates of good Scotch whisky crashes on their shores – and the villagers are determined to hide every single drop for themselves.

**The Maggie** (1954 – known as **High and Dry** for its American release) is a story of a clash of cultures between a hard-driving American businessman and a wily Scottish sea-captain. The American is conned into shipping a valuable load of cargo to a Scottish island via a run-down coal-powered boat.
