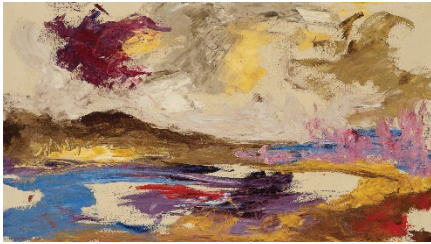

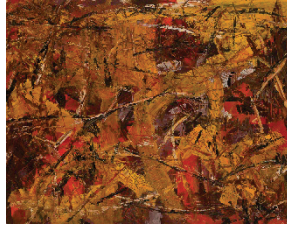

Museum Acquisitions:

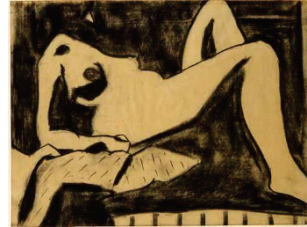

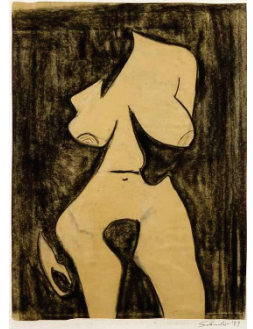
Vineyard Study, 1957, 20 x 36 in. (o/c 57-21)

That's Just It, 1949, 17 x 23 in. (dr. 49-40)



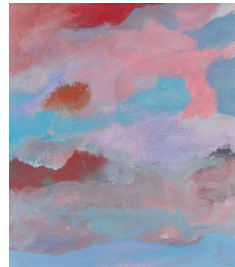
Cut It Out, 1949, 23 x 17 in. (dr. 49-42)

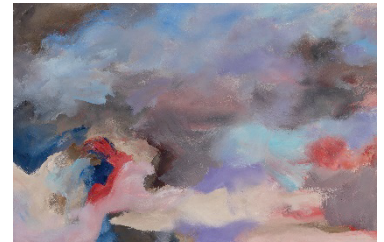

The Sound of Sleat: Red in a Summer Night VIII, 1970, 40 x 48 in. (o/c 14)

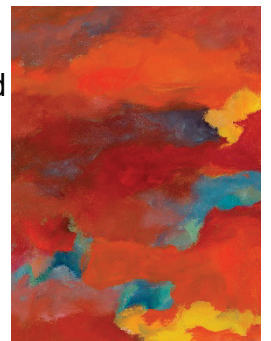
